Interesting Features

- Portion of property identified by the Kawarthas Naturally Connected Collaboration using the best available conservation science as an important piece of our natural landscape.
- Over 40 species of birds observed on the property including Yellow-Billed Cuckoo, Pileated Woodpecker, Eastern Wood-Pewee and Rose-breasted Grosbeak.
- The property is dominated by mixed canopy forests with species including various maple, hemlock, balsam fir and white birch. Minimal logging activity has occurred.
- Sizable wetland home to a biodiversity of flora and fauna.
- Numerous vernal pools located throughout the northern half of the property. Vernal pools provide critical habitat for many species-at-risk.
